The coconut industry is an important source of foreign exchange earning & employment generation for Sri Lanka. A total of 1,095,982 Acres are under coconut cultivation of which 178,675 Acres are under estate sector and 917,307 Acres are under small holdings. An area of 34,063 Acres are used for cultivation of king coconut. Annual nut production is estimated at 2,623.10 Mn nuts in year 2018.

Coconut trees are grown in tropical countries mainly for the high oil content of the endosperm (copra), which is widely used in both food and non-food industries (e.g., margarine and soaps). Large production areas, in particular, are found along the coastal regions in the wet tropical areas of Asia in the Philippines, Indonesia, India, Sri Lanka and Malaysia. In these countries millions of people make a living from the coconut palm and its many products.
